

Board of the Goetheanum Co-leader of the Pedagogical Section and the General Anthroposophical Section

Born in Chile in 1967 and raised in Brazil, studied Mathematics in São Paulo. She taught for 19 years at the Escola Rudolf Steiner, where she also worked in the Waldorf teacher training. She holds a Ph.D. in Education with a thesis on Nicolaus of Cuse.



EDUARDO RINCÓN

Co-leader of the Section for Agriculture

Studied Biology and earned a master's in Phenomenology applied to Art and Science. He worked on research in tropical plant ecology in the Gulf of Mexico and farmed for nearly a decade in a high dessert region. Co-founded the Biodynamic Association of Mexico, and served as its president (2018-2023). He was also Mexico's representative in the founding of the Biodynamic Federation Demeter International (BFDI).

From 2002 to 2006, was head physician at the Ita Wegman Clinic (adolescent psychiatry and psychotherapy) and founded the Ita Wegman Institute for Basic Anthroposophical Research.

Board Member, Swiss Anthroposophical Society Founder & Board Member, L'Aubier

Born in 1956, physicist and entrepreneur. Founded L'Aubier in Montezillon, Neuchâtel, in 1979 (Demeter farm, store and restaurant, eco-hotel and seminar center, training in associative economics) and has been a member of the management board since then. In 1985, co-founded the COOPERA Pension Fund in Bern and served as a trustee until 2020. Board member of the Swiss Anthroposophical Society, general secretary and treasurer.
